Welding demonstration and practical assessment in the workshop, which will be delivered by Dave Martin of Stanners Equipment.

Day Two will consist of the following presentations and training.

Structural Adhesives, the correct use of adhesives and how to carry out panel replacement when faced with existing adhesives from original vehicle. This will be presented by representatives of the industry leaders who are 3m, and Teroson, supported by Dave Martin of Stanners Equipment.

Riveting Systems; The use of riveting in vehicle body repairs, there application and use, with demonstration. Presentation by Dave Martin of Stanners Equipment, representing Avdel Ltd the Industry leaders in Riveting Technology.

A presentation about British Standards welding certification will be given, followed by an assessment paper, and question time..
